## CONSUMER PRICE INDEX NUMBERS WITH BASE YEAR 2010=100 FOR RURAL, URBAN & COMBINED FOR THE QUARTER JULY-SEPTEMBER 2020

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Nagaland is releasing the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Rural, Urban & Combined with Base year 2010=100 for the Quarter July-September 2020. In addition to CPI for Rural, Urban & Combined the Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for Rural, Urban and Combined are also being estimated and released for the same Quarter. All Nagaland Inflation rates (on point to point basis i.e. current Quarter over the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2020) and monthly changes based on General Indices and Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) are also provided.

The State General (all-Groups), Group and Sub-Group level for CPI & CFPI numbers for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2020 for Rural, Urban and Combined are given in **Annexure I**. The General Indices for the 3<sup>rd</sup>Quarter for Rural, Urban & Combined are 149.37, 140.39 & 143.82 respectively. The CFPI for Rural, Urban & Combined are 150.19, 147.84 & 140.18 respectively.

The monthly changes in the General Indices shows that in the rural areas, the CPI (General) has increased by 4% during the period July-August, whereas, during the period August-September the index has decreased by -1%. Similarly, in the urban areas, the index has increased by 2% during the period July-August, whereas, it has decreased by -1% during the period August-September. In the Combined sector (Rural and Urban) the index has increased by 3% during July-August but decreased by -1% during the period August-September. The CFPI for rural areas has increased by 4% during the period July-August, whereas, the number has decreased by -2% during the period August-September. Similarly, in the urban areas the CFPI has increased by 2% during July-August but the index has decreased by -1% during August-September. The CFPI for combined sector has increased by 2% during the period July-August, whereas, the index has decreased by -0.1.8% during August –September.

The  $3^{rd}$  quarter inflation rates base on CPIs (General) for Rural, Urban and Combined have shown an increasing rate of 7%, 2% & 5% respectively over the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2020. CFPIs for Rural, Urban have increased by 7% & 2% respectively over the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2020, whereas, the CFPI for Combined has decreased by -0.5% over the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2020.
